

# Student Nurse Functions

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Following appropriate instruction and supervision, the student will:

1. Employ critical thinking and problem solving in the application of the nursing process to client care.
2. Accurately assess needs/condition of clients.
3. Participate in planning the care of the client.
4. Implement nursing measures to give safe and effective care to clients, including:
  - a. Administering physical care which often requires moving/lifting clients and/or equipment and performing gross & fine motor skills.
  - b. Performing nursing procedures which may require standing for extended periods, the ability to stoop or bend, maneuvering in confined spaces.
5. Participate in the evaluation of client care.
6. Communicate & interact appropriately with clients, families, and other members of the health care team including:
  - a. Verbal communication
  - b. Written communication
  - c. Interaction with individuals & groups from a variety of cultures & backgrounds
7. Maintain a safe and appropriate environment for clients.
8. Attend class sessions which may involve sitting for extended periods with short breaks periodically.
9. Take written scheduled examinations related to course/clinical curriculum, in the normally allotted time frame of approximately 1 multiple choice question per minute.
