### Southwestern Total Online Records Management

In the eSTORM Student Center, you can search and register\* for classes, apply for Foundation scholarships, check your financial-aid status, print class schedules, see account statements and payment deadlines, make a payment, view grades, apply for graduation, request transcripts and more.

To activate your account, visit [estorm.swic.edu](http://estorm.swic.edu) and click New User. Activation requires that you have completed online orientation or enrolled in a class. You will also need your student ID number, Social Security number and date of birth.
