Step 1: Identify your first class of your first day, then second, then third, and so on to walk through your courses in order. *Example: This class meets Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 9 – 9:50 AM.*

Step 2: Locate your room numbers on your class schedule and head to your destination. *Example: Belleville indicates campus, LA indicates building, 3 indicates 3rd floor, and 323 indicates the room number.*
