1. Tour the Library

A Librarian will lead the way through SWIC's library collection. The walking tour will showcase the main service points, along with specific collection and service points at your campus library. Length of tour varies by campus.

2. Web Research & Evaluation

There's more to the web than just Wikipedia! Librarians will teach students how to navigate the web efficiently through advanced search engine functions, selecting search terms and web evaluation skills.

3. SWIC Library Catalog: The Basics

Shelves and shelves of books at the library can be overwhelming when the research process begins. Students will be taught how to look up books in SWIC's online library catalog, retrieve books from the shelf using the Library of Congress callnumber system and request books from other libraries.

4. Got Articles? Library Research Databases

Popular and scholarly (peer-reviewed) articles reside in these easy to use, online resources. Students will learn how to locate articles on their topic while practicing their keyword building skills. All full-text articles can be printed, e-mailed or saved to a computer or flash drive. Many additional resources (news transcripts, statistics, court cases, company dossiers, etc.) are tucked away in these research databases too!

5. Books Galore!

Book sources abound! Students will learn how to find books in three places: SWIC's library catalog, a worldwide library catalog called WorldCat, and Google Books. Students will learn how to request a library book. Requesting books from other libraries is easy and FREE!

6. Library Overview Assignment: Tell Me About the Library

Students will be given a library assignment that asks questions about general library services. An answer key will be given to the instructor in person or via e-mail. This assignment can be used as a class grade or extra credit.

7. Library Research Assignment: Apply Your Knowledge

This challenge can be assigned after students attend research sessions #4 and #5. See what your students have learned about researching articles and books. An answer key will be given to the instructor in person or via e-mail. Use as a class grade or extra credit.
