STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES WHO USE ADAPTIVE TECHNOLOGY/SOFTWARE

Need help with your eSTORM account or the SWIC online student orientation?
The **Disability & Access Center** can help!

Learn how to access the following information:

- **Account Statement** - View the details of charges and credits posted to your account.
- **Make a Payment** - Make a tuition payment or submit payment for a rush/fax transcript.
- **Course Schedule** - View and print current and past course schedules.
- **Final Grade Report** - View your final grades online.
- **Forms** - Apply for graduation or request a certificate, official transcript or transcript evaluation.
- **Register for Classes** - Current students may register for classes online.
- **Transcripts** - View unofficial transcripts or request that an official transcript be sent to you or to another location.
- **Advisor** - This is an automated degree audit software program. Advisor applies your completed coursework toward degree/certificate requirements. It is not an official record and does not replace the transcript. It is a tool to aid students preparing to meet with an academic advisor in Enrollment Services to confirm eligibility for graduation or course selection.
- **Much More** - The Disability & Access Center staff also can help you use Blackboard and other software applications.
