Conditions

Sophomore Scholarship

A tuition scholarship awarded to outstanding sophomore students (three per campus – Belleville, Granite City, Red Bud) who meet the following criteria.

1. The student must file a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) listing Southwestern Illinois College, (School code: 001636) as a choice of school in the college release section.
2. The student must have completed at least 30 but no more than 45 semester hours at SWIC (excluding transfer hours) at the time of application, with a cumulative 3.5 GPA. All hours from other colleges must be transferred to SWIC and evaluated for the student's degree prior to the August 1 deadline. Transfer hours in combination with SWIC hours may not exceed 96 attempted credit hours.
3. The student is encouraged to take as many credit hours as possible at the sponsoring campus. Enrollments at another campus necessary to complete major requirements will be taken into consideration.
4. The scholarship is for tuition only for classes that appear on student's academic transcripts. The scholarship does **NOT** pay fees, books, or proficiency examination costs.
5. The scholarship is awarded for two consecutive semesters (fall and spring) and does not cover the summer semester. There are no leaves of absence.
6. The scholarship will be awarded for up to a maximum of 18 credit hours per semester.
7. The student must be enrolled full-time each semester (minimum of 12 hours per semester) to receive the scholarship.
8. If the student is eligible for federal and state grant aid, additional information may be required and will be requested by the Financial Aid and Student Employment Office.
10. The student must maintain satisfactory progress (minimum 3.0 semester and cumulative GPA and a 67% cumulative completion rate) to receive the award for the second semester.
11. Only **complete** applications received by the August 1 deadline will be considered.
12. The SWIC Scholarship Committee will determine the recipients based upon the above criteria and will notify applicants in writing of the decision.

If you are selected, you will also receive an award letter showing the amount of the award. The scholarship does **NOT** pay fees, books, or proficiency examination costs. Tuition due prior to receipt of the award letter will be the responsibility of the student, but any qualifying tuition paid will be refunded to the student after the scholarship is disbursed.

- **All applicants:** Make sure that SWIC has received the results of your processed Free Application for Federal Student Aid for the award year that you wish to receive the scholarship. The FAFSA is available on-line by going to www.studentaid.gov. SWIC's school code is 001636.
- You are encouraged to take as many credit hours as possible at the sponsoring campus. Enrollment at another campus necessary to complete major requirements will be taken into consideration.

- A. I certify the information reported on this application is true to the best of my knowledge. I have read the conditions of this scholarship as outlined and understand that:
- B. Renewal requires that I maintain a 3.0 or higher GPA per semester and a cumulative completion rate of at least 67%. Cumulative completion rate is equal to hours earned divided by hours attempted.
- C. Above requirements must be met there is no appeal process for this scholarship.
