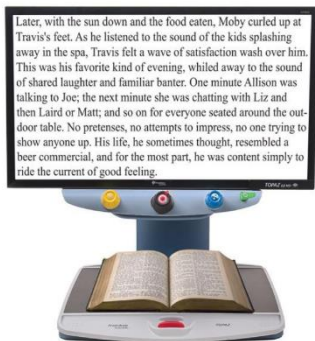


Inclusive Resources @ SWIC LIBRARY!

Accessibility Software is available on public access computers. This software helps to bring online resources to more people.

- **ZoomText** software helps magnify the text on the computer to aid those with low vision. ZoomText Magnifier/Reader is a fully integrated magnification and reading program tailored for low-vision users. Magnifier/Reader enlarges and enhances everything on the computer screen, echoes a person's typing and essential program activity, and automatically reads documents, web pages, email.
- **Laptops** for checkout are installed with Accessibility Software



Assistive Technology

- **Large Print Screen Readers** - All libraries have at least one computer station with a Large Print Screen Reader.
- **Height Adjustable Tables** - Provides wheelchair users and other mobility impaired persons easy access to desktop work area.
- **Large Print Keyboards**

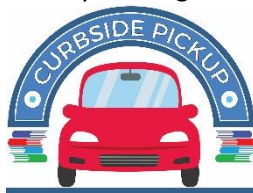


ADA-Accessible Tables and Workstations - All libraries have ADA-accessible tables
