- 50.00BN is the course fee including textbook from Barnes & Noble Bookstore

of purchasing the textbook through course fees. Course Fees and/ or BN Fees are identified for each course in this class schedule or online through eStorm.


By registering for classes, students accept full financial responsibility for tuition and fee charges.

How to Find Your Final Exam Schedule


The final exam schedule will be listed in the eSTORM class details. Students encountering conflicts with their final exams should contact their instructors for alternative exam options.
