1st TIME APPEAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The Financial Aid Suspension Appeal you are submitting will be evaluated by the SAP Appeal Committee. You will be notified by e-mail once a decision has been made.

If your appeal is granted, you are designated as a PLAN student which signifies your agreement to follow your academic plan according to your appeal. A PLAN status lasts until you complete your program(s) of study or cumulative GPA and cumulative completion rate return to MEET status. **Changing your program will cause loss of PLAN status**, and you will go back on Suspension and/or Timeframe Suspension. You will be reviewed at the end of every semester to ensure you are meeting all of the following requirements to maintain your PLAN status into the next semester:

- You continue to pursue your program(s) of study.
- You only enroll in and complete classes required for your program(s) of study.
- You maintain a minimum semester GPA of at least a 2.0.
- You maintain a minimum semester completion rate of at least a 67%.
- You do not exceed the maximum timeframe allowed for your primary program of study.

PLEASE NOTE: Failing any of the requirements listed above will return you to a financial aid suspension status.

If your appeal is denied, you are no longer eligible for financial aid at SWIC and you will remain on financial aid suspension. The Committee's decision is final and you cannot appeal this decision.

A suspension appeal may be denied for one of the following reasons:

- Insufficient academic improvement at SWIC
- Citing the same or similar obstacles on more than one appeal
- Failure to document extenuating circumstances
- Lack of effort on the appeal
- Other reasons as decided by the appeal committee

Financial options after a denied suspension appeal include:

- Paying for classes out of pocket Payment plans are available through the Business Office
- Alternative Loans through a Private Lender
- Scholarships
