## **Full-Time and Part-Time Police Officers**

The City of Grafton Police Department is currently accepting applications for **one (1) Full-Time Police Officer** and **multiple Part-Time Police Officer** positions.

Applicants must be certified through the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board (ILETSB) and be available to work nights, weekends, and varying shift schedules. Shifts may consist of 8-, 10-, or 12-hour assignments. Uniforms and equipment will be provided.

## **Minimum Qualifications**

- Must be a certified police officer in the State of Illinois through the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board (ILETSB).
- Must successfully pass a background investigation.
- Must be in good standing with any current or previous law enforcement agency.
- Must be at least 21 years of age.
- Must have no felony convictions or disqualifying misdemeanor convictions.
- Must maintain all training and certification requirements established by ILETSB.
- Must be available to work nights, weekends, and holidays as required.
- Part-time officers must be available to work a minimum of three (3) shifts per month.
